GRACE NOTE

Claiming Jesus and the big "D!"

I have been reading about the imperial Christianity, also termed Nationalist Christianity that permeates this society's experience of Christians. The ideology is not new. It's imbedded in our Christian history when Emperor Constantine in 380 CE declared it the official state religion of the Roman Empire. What was persecuted before was now revered; Jesus became the patron of the Roman Army.

Throughout history, societies have struggled with interpreting the religious traditions and writings. We are seeing this conflict again with the visible manifestations of violence against each other in this country. At a recent national riot, I saw signs of "Jesus Saves" and the cross as they attacked a national institution.

A young member some years ago was embarrassed to claim Christianity as her religion because of these atrocities. Jesus' name was used to justify killing!

This is not the Jesus I follow. I am mortified at the abuse and use of Jesus's name. I am not ashamed of being Christian. I am, though, complicit, if I don't counter this belief with the beliefs I hold as the truth, the way, and the life of love through Jesus Christ.

All the more that I am convicted to claim Jesus as my teacher of love, of justice, of compassion, of redemption, of grace. I am convicted to seek the ways of discipleship that serves in humility, accompanies the grieving, welcomes the marginalized.

That is the big "D!" Discipleship. That is what church is about. And that is the vision I have for Wesley—to learn and know how to be a disciple, how to worship and celebrate God as a disciple, and how to serve God and God's creation as a disciple.

Will you walk with me on this journey of discipleship?
